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## OMCE 2021 Board of Directors Nominations Open April 2, 2021

Each year at this time we begin our search for OMCE members who may be interested in serving on the OMCE Board of Directors. There are four seats to be filled this year, each for a three year term.

The OMCE Board of Directors is charged with providing guidance and direction, and setting policy for the organization. Board members are advocates of many and diverse interests and reflect different experiences. As our governing board, members address issues of importance and concern to M/C employees and retirees, reach agreement through consensus, and direct the OMCE staff, law firm and consultants to take necessary and appropriate action.

The nominations process is easy since a member can self-nominate. Just submit your resume, a letter stating your interest to run for a Board seat and a statement that can be used for the ballot, describing your background and experience, the issues and priorities you would want to focus on as a Board member and why members should choose you. Nominations are reviewed by the Nominations Committee members who will present a slate of nominees to the Board and, if needed, arrange for the mail ballot. Nominations, via e-mail or regular mail, must be received in the OMCE office no later than June 10, 2021. Board members are expected to participate in four Board meetings per year (March, June, September, December) in person, video conference or phone and to serve on at least one committee. Board members receive no compensation but travel expenses for OMCE meetings are reimbursed at state rates.
